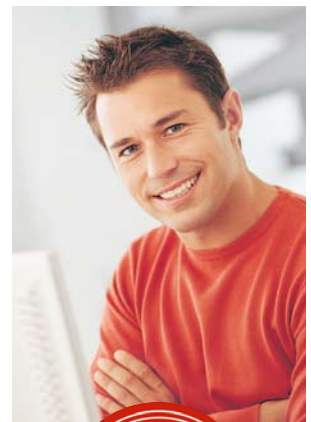

Protect Yourself from *Identity Theft*

Identify theft has become a big problem in the United States, with millions of people affected every year. But what exactly is it, and how can you help prevent it?

What it is

Identity theft occurs when an unauthorized person gets ahold of your personal information such as your Social Security, driver's license, and credit card numbers. With this type of information, criminals can open credit cards or receive loans in your name—which can ultimately damage your credit rating and make it hard to obtain loans for things you need.

How to protect yourself

Here are a few easy ways to help prevent identity theft:

Use caution when making online purchases.

Web-based purchases are actually more secure than you may expect because your credit card number is encrypted. However, it's important to purchase only from secure sites. Those with security certificates will display an icon of a lock in the lower right-hand corner of your Web browser.

Watch out for “phishing” attacks.

These include phony e-mails that appear to be from businesses you would normally trust (places like large national banks, PayPal, eBay, and others). They commonly ask you to verify personal

information in order to prevent your account from being closed, or they state that unauthorized purchases may have been made through your account. Never respond to these messages, and don't click links that are included in them. Legitimate businesses won't ask for personal information via e-mails.

Block Web pop-ups.

When you're visiting a new or unfamiliar site, do not allow pop-ups. Some will actually install software that allows people to hack into your computer system.

Don't supply private information in stores.

When you're making purchases in person, your private information can be stolen even more easily. Salespeople should not need to document your Social Security number, phone number, or driver's license number to allow you to make a purchase.

Check your credit report once a year.

You're entitled to a free credit report from each of the three credit bureaus: TransUnion (www.transunion.com), Equifax (www.equifax.com), and Experian (www.experian.com). Take advantage of this service, and watch for any errors or unauthorized activity. Report errors to the credit bureaus immediately.

Be Prepared When Calling the Help Desk

If you ever need to call KMTelecom for help resolving an issue with your Internet service, you'll want to be prepared to answer several key questions. By having this information handy before you call, we'll be able to serve you more efficiently:

1. Your user name or e-mail address.
2. Telephone number.
3. Your PC's operating system (such as Windows XP or Windows Vista).
4. Your modem's brand name (such as Paradyne, BEC, Pannaway) and whether it connects directly to your computer or if you use a router.
5. Any error messages that are appearing, if any. Write them down if necessary.



If possible, it's best to have your computer on and running when you call as well. And remember—our Help Desk is available 24 hours a day/7 days a week at 634-2575 from Kasson, Mantorville and Rock Dell or 633-2575 from Dodge Center.

Take Action Against Unwanted Promotions

Would you like to reduce the amount of junk mail and telemarketing calls coming to your home? Just register with these sites:

Do Not Call

www.donotcall.gov

If you're not on the Do Not Call list—or if you've changed or added phone numbers since you registered—check out this site. You can enter up to three phone numbers, and after 30 days, most telemarketers should stop calling these numbers.

Do Not Write

www.dmaconsumers.org/offmailinglist.html

To cut back on promotional mail, register with the Mail Preference Service (MPS), sponsored by the Direct Marketing Association. These lists are updated four times a year, so within a few months, you should see a decrease in solicitations from companies that you haven't done business with previously.
