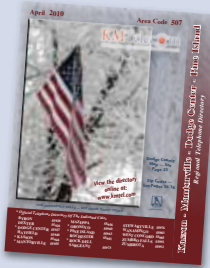




## New 2011 Directories are Coming Soon!

## Service Upgrade Plans A Message from Mary Ehmke, COO



At KMTelecom, we're working to make improvements to our communications services and infrastructure despite the challenges of these tough economic times. As your local provider, we remain committed to bringing you reliable and affordable solutions to keep you connected with the people and resources that matter most. We are currently adding HD (high definition) to our TV service, deploying digital video recorder (DVR) services to a greater number of customers and increasing our high speed Internet to beyond 20 Mbps.

### Improvement Plan/Goals:

**Kasson** – The improved services that are currently available are: KMTV HD and DVR service, and faster high speed Internet of 5 Mbps, 10 Mbps, and 20 Mbps.

**Mantorville** – Construction of the new fiber-optic network will begin this summer with plans to have these new services available to customers by the end of 2011: KMTV HD and DVR service, and faster high speed Internet of 5 Mbps, 10 Mbps, and 20 Mbps.

**Dodge Center** – KMTV HD is currently available. There are plans in place to add additional HD channels and DVR service, and faster high speed Internet of 5 Mbps, 10 Mbps, and 20 Mbps in the fall of 2011. There will not be additional construction in Dodge Center. Our current facilities will be upgraded as well as the equipment in your home/business to bring these enhanced services to you.

**Rock Dell** – Faster high speed Internet up to 5 Mbps will be available in 2012 in some areas.

*Availability of these services will depend on location. It is important to note there are many factors involved with upgrades that are beyond our control. Every effort will be made to complete the upgrades as planned but we cannot guarantee that these plans won't be altered or delayed.*

## Get Converted to the Fiber Network

Kasson construction of fiber to the home (FTTH) is complete. We are currently in the conversion process to get homes and businesses switched over from the old copper plant to the new fiber-optic network. The new fiber-optic network improves KMTelecom services in your home or business.

**Attention Kasson residents:** If you have not been converted to the fiber network, give us a call. Our customer service representatives are waiting to hear from you. This conversion will cost you nothing. Faster Internet speeds and enhanced TV services are available. However, the conversion does not require you to make any changes at this time. Our goal is to set your home up on the new network so you can benefit from the most up-to-date technology available.

# Grant Money Presented to Triton Schools

In 1989, the Organization for the Promotion and Advancement of Small Telecommunications Companies (OPASTCO) created the Foundation for Rural Education and Development (FRED) to address the educational and developmental needs of rural areas. The Foundation's mission is to sponsor programs and activities that improve the educational, social, and economic conditions of rural areas.

The FRED Technology Grants Committee reviewed almost 90 applications in 2010. As a result, seven schools have received a grant. Triton Elementary School was presented with a grant for \$8,200. ## Is Your Home Network Secure?

Did you know your network is susceptible to hacker attacks? Here are security tips to make your wireless connection safe:

1. Change your router's default access name, use a strong password and wireless encryption.
2. Position the router safely in the center of your home to minimize the distance the signal reaches outside of your home.
3. Don't broadcast your SSID (the name you give your wireless network).
4. Enable firewalls on each computer and the router.
5. Turn off wireless cards and routers when not in use.
6. Approve all wireless network users. You are liable for all content downloaded on your network.
7. Periodically check router logs for rogue users.

## Stand Up to Cyberbullying

Cyberbullying is just what it sounds like—bullying that takes place in the virtual world. Cyberbullying typically occurs between children and teens and, like traditional in-person bullying, can be very emotionally harmful.

Though cyberbullying shares many characteristics of yesterday's bullying, it has these unique elements:

- It can be anonymous, so victims may not know who is doing the cyberbullying.
- Because they cannot see the response of the victim, cyberbullies may not recognize the level of harm they are causing.
- It is public (online for anyone to see).
- Many adults lack the technological experience to monitor or intervene in cyberbullying activities.

According to the Stop Cyberbullying website ([stopcyberbullying.org](http://stopcyberbullying.org)), common cyberbullying activities include repeated malicious e-mails or instant messages; signing the victim up for unfavorable sites or junk e-mail; posting embarrassing images of the victim online; and posting or encouraging others to post nasty comments on the victim's Facebook page.

Parents should be watchful for behavior that might indicate their child is a cyberbullying victim, or a cyberbully. For example, according to the Cyberbullying Research Center website,



a child or teen may be the victim of cyberbullying if he or she unexpectedly stops using their computer or cell phone. Similarly, a child or teen may be engaging in cyberbullying behaviors if he or she appears to be using multiple online accounts (or an account that is not his or her own).

Start with these tips to keep your kids from becoming victims:

**Stay involved.** Know what your kids are up to online, including which communities they participate in. Have the computer set up in a public area of the house.

**Educate them.** Tell your kids that anything they post in an electronic format can be made public. Remind them to think before they click.

**Talk to them.** Let them know what you consider to be acceptable online behavior, and the consequences for not following these guidelines.
