

# **Programming Your KMTV Remote**

## TV, AUD, DVD, VCR, STB

Use one remote to control multiple devices.

#### **SETUP**

Use for programming devices controlled by the remote.

## SKIP FORWARD, SKIP BACK, REWIND, PLAY, FORWARD, STOP, PAUSE, RECORD

These control the DVR functions.

#### **MENU-**

Displays the menu.

#### **GUIDE**

Opens the Program Guide.

#### DAY +/- -

Jump ahead or back one day in the Program Guide.

## **COLOR NAVIGATION**

These buttons will have several functions. Actions will be indicated at the bottom of your TV screen. While viewing a channel these buttons will be used accordingly.

- **Weather** Current conditions and 5 day forecast.
- Caller ID Log Recent calls and messages. Phone line required.
- **What's Hot** Will show you most watched TV, recordings and series.
- **Favorites** From the GUIDE, pull up Favorite channels that you have set up.

#### VOL +/- -

Raise or lower the volume.

### **MUTE** -

Turn the sound off or on.

# **ASPECT RATIO**

If applicable, temporarily change the conversion mode from Original Size or Fit to Screen.

#### **INPUT**

In TV control mode, will change the input of the device you are controlling.



POWER

Turn on/off a selected device.

LIVE

Return to watching live TV.

LIST

Display a list of recorded, future and series rules on your DVR.

- INFO

Display the current channel and program information.

BROWSE, SEARCH, ARROW, OK

Navigate and select onscreen choices.

(BROWSE) RIGHT ARROW

Browse current station.

(SEARCH) LEFT ARROW

Search for a full title or word within a title of a program.

— EXIT

Exit the current screen.

PAGE +/-

Page up or down in lists and Program Guide.

CHANNEL +/-

Changes to the next higher or lower channel.

- LAST

Recall the last channel you were watching.

- FAV

View your favorite channels.

- NUMBER KEYS (0-9)

Directly select a channel or enter options.

**CLOSED CAPTIONING** 

Turn on and off.

# **Programming Your Remote Using Brand Code**

Make sure your TV set is turned on. (The set-top box does not need to be turned on to perform this programming feature.)

- 1. Manually turn ON the TV that you want to program to the remote.
- 2. Press and release the **TV** button.
- 3. Press and hold the **SETUP** button until the **TV** button blinks twice.
- 4. Press and release the **TV** button again.
  - The TV button will now stay lit.
- 5. Find your TV brand from the chart and note the assigned number.
- 6. Press and hold down the **NUMBER** button for your brand while pointing the remote at the TV.
- 7. Let go of the button when your TV turns off.
- 8. Press the **POWER** button to turn your TV on.
- 9. Press and hold **SETUP** until the **TV** button blinks twice.
- 10. Enter 9 9 5. The TV button will blink twice.
- 11. Press **POWER** once.
- 12. Press **STB** once.
- 13. Press TV once.
- 14. Press and hold **SETUP** until the TV button blinks twice.
- 15. Press STB.

The remote is now programmed for the assigned TV.

# **Programming Remote Using Auto Search**

If your TV's brand is not listed above, then the Auto Search method can be used.

Note: This process may take up to 5 minutes to find your TV code.

- 1. Manually turn on your TV.
- 2. Press the TV button once.
  - The TV button will blink once.
- 3. Press and HOLD the **SETUP** button until the **TV** button blinks twice.
- 4. Type 9 9 1.
  - The TV button will blink twice.
- 5. Press and release the **CH +** button continuously until the TV turns off.
  - The remote searches through codes from its built-in library using this method.
- 6. Press the **SETUP** button after the TV turns off.
  - The TV button light will blink twice to indicate that the code is saved.
- 7. Press the **POWER** button to turn the TV back on.
- 8. Follow steps 9-15 above.

The remote is now programmed for the assigned TV.
